A Little About Us

Our History

The Prosser Farmers Market was formed under the Agriculture Committee of the Prosser Economic Development Association chaired by Max Benitz, Jr., Gayle Wheeler, Director, and Linda Hall in 1993 and opened with the assistance of the Port of Benton on July 17, 1993 with seven vendors. The market was located at the Prosser Airport during the 1993 and 1994 seasons. In 1995 the market relocated to it's current location on Sommers Avenue, adjacent to the Prosser City Park and Prosser Public Library with the assistance of Ken Carter and the Prosser City Council.

In the fall of 2000, with the assistance of the Benton Rural Electric Association, the Market obtained a U.S.D.A. grant administered by the Northwest Cooperative Development Center. After many years of support from the Prosser Economic Development Association, our own cooperative called the Farmers Market Co-op was formed. We will be celebrating our fifteenth birthday this July. We strive for growth and improvement each year, making the Market a venue the community can be proud of.

What's Happening This Season

The Market successfully completed a WSU Farmers Market Wireless Technology Project grant application funded by the WSDA. It's purpose, to develop the technological capacity of WA farmers markets allowing shoppers to pay with credit/debit cards or SNAP (food stamp) benefits. Wooden tokens will be distributed for the amount charged on customer cards. Value of the grant award is \$1,500 for equipment, marketing materials and support training. Special thanks to Sue Derryberry, President and Linda Hall, Treasurer for their highly successful grant submission.

We're ready for a great season with a full line up of vendors and events. In addition to our great selection of fresh fruits & vegetables we have arts & crafts, wine, Buhrmaster Bakery fresh baked breads and Beecher's cheese curds. Kiwanis will be there serving up their pancake, sausage & egg breakfast to kick-start your morning and as usual great musical entertainment on hand!
